

Definitions:

Legal Laws are made by God or man and they mandate what is acceptable behavior for people. These laws may be broken but there is usually a penalty.

Scientific Laws are statements based on repeated experiments or observations which (*unfailingly*) describe natural phenomena – Wikipedia.

If any such statement fails even once, it is no longer considered a law.

Spiritual Laws describe cause and effect relationships in the spiritual and physical worlds. Such laws are based on the Word of God and so can never fail – ABC.

Foundation Scriptures:

Mat 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

Gen 1:26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, v28 replenish the earth and subdue it.

Overview:

Luk 16:17 It is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.

Mal 3:6 For I [am] the LORD, I change not;

It can be seen from these scriptures that all of the WOG may be considered as a law; but today we are focusing on the four laws which can be used by an individual, you or me, in order to create outcomes which we desire.

A. Law of Creation.

Man was made in the likeness of God with creative power in his tongue.

1. **What:** Gen 1 God spoke 10 times and created the world.
2. **Why:** Gen 1:26 We are made in the image and likeness of God. We were made to create.
3. **How:** Num 14:22 The Israelites murmured 10 times and created their destiny of dying off in the wilderness. *We create with our spoken words (Pro 18:21).*
4. **Benefit:** Mark 11:23 You have what you say, when you live a lifestyle of believing that whatever you say will come to pass (i.e., be created).

B. Law of Genesis.

1. **What:** Everything produces after its own kind.
Gen 1:12 And the earth brought forth grass, [and] herb yielding seed after his kind, and the tree yielding fruit, whose seed [was] in itself, after his kind: and God saw that [it was] good.
2. **Why:** Gen 1:28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it:
3. **How:** Exo 21:23 then thou shalt give life for life,
Exo 21:24 Eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot,
Gal 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

4. **Benefit:** Luke 6:38 Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.

C. Law of Binding and Loosing.

1. **What:** Mat 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven (*in the heavenlies*).
2. **Why:** Mat 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.
Mat 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations,
Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils;
3. **How:** Phi 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;
4. **Benefit:** Joh 20:23 Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; [and] whose soever [sins] ye retain, they are retained.

D. Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus.

1. **What:** Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
2. **Why:** Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:
Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.
Believest thou this?
3. **How:** Rom 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
Rom 6:12 Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof.
Rom 6:13 Neither yield ye your members [as] instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members [as] instruments of righteousness unto God.
Rom 6:16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness.
4. **Benefit:** 1 Co 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep (*die*), but we shall all be changed,
1 Co 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
